## Known Graves

The records below show known graves. The monumental inscription (MI) is given, where one exists, supplemented by the burial register (BR) entry<sup>1</sup>. The latter has been pruned to only show additional information; so age for example is not given if the MI already shows it. The exception to this is where MI and BR do not agree when the BR entry will normally have 'sic' after it to confirm the apparent anomaly has been checked. Suspected anomalies in the spelling of the name or age have been checked against the General Register Office (GRO) index back to 1837.

Dates In Sep 1752, England switched from the Julian to the Gregorian Calendar. In order to achieve the change, 11 days were 'omitted' from the calendar - i.e. the day after 2 Sep 1752 was 14 Sep 1752. In addition the first day of the year was changed. Prior to 1752 in England, the year began on 25 Mar (Lady Day). Lady Day is one of the Quarter Days. The Quarter Days divide the year in quarters (hence the name), the Quarter Days being: Lady Day (25 Mar), Midsummers Day (24 Jun), Michaelmas Day (29 Sep), and Christmas Day (25 Dec). So, in England, the day after 24 Mar 1642 was 25 Mar 1643. The Act changed this, so that the day after 31 Dec 1751 was 1 Jan 1752. As a consequence, 1751 was a short year - it ran only from 25 Mar to 31 Dec. Thus in the burial dates above, for example, 25 Jan 1748 is after 2 Dec 1748.
